


#### Q1 What school do you attend?




### Q3 What's your race or cultural identity?



## Q4 What's your age?





## Q5 What's your gender?





	No sympathy from a good 95% of faculty members. Yes we're kids but we have a lot going on, we have lives that we go back to when we leave school. School only takes up not even a full 7 hours of our day that leaves 17 other hours for everything else, and for a lot of us that entails, practice, work, helping out around the house, and whatever else we have to do during the day, then school work or studying, which usually doesn't happen until later on in the day and that's either before or after dinner. So at this point it's usually pretty late at night so we spend around 2 or 3 hours studying or doing homework depending on the student thought it's a majority of us and by the time we get done we have to shower or we go to sleep and wake up at least 45 minutes earlier than normal and normal is usually around 5 o'clock or 5:30 and that's before covid and God forbid out of over almost 5 months you have more than 11 absences excused or not, because then you have to get a C+. Yep, you miss 11 days out of 135 and you face redoing a class no matter if you have a 115% in the class or a %60. NOW couple in covid. Because it cut into our previous school year there was no way to improve our gpa's so now even those of us that had the potential to qualify for the Muskegon promise now can only qualify if they get a 4.0 from here on out. And not to mention the fact that some student's gpa's dropped when covid hit unexpectedly and school faculty members are writing it off and saying it isn't possible. And the lack of understanding and failure to take into mind how certain decisions about US will affect US is one of the leading reasons that so many students suffer from psychological and anxiety disorders. So if something can be done about that, I know a lot of us would greatly appreciate it.


When calculating a weighted average - using the two most severe rating categories - the following were determined to be the top 3 issues Muskegon County youth face based on the 2021 YES:
